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### **INDIANA mSA'S UNEMPLOYMENT RATE AT 7.1% IN AUGUST**

**HARRISBURG (SEPTEMBER 28)** – The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for the Indiana Micropolitan Statistical Area (mSA) was down two-tenths of a percentage point over the month to 7.1% in August. The statewide rate fell one-tenth of a percentage point to 6.4 percent, and the national rate declined by two-tenths of a point to 5.2 percent.

**Total nonfarm jobs (not seasonally adjusted) in the Indiana mSA rose 200 from July to 28,000 in August.**

**August Not Seasonally Adjusted Nonfarm Jobs Detail (see Table 2)**

Jobs were essentially unchanged over the month in all nine published supersectors.

**Please note that due to demand for pre-recession data, table 2 has been temporarily modified to exclude 2-months ago data in order to include 24-months ago data. This change will be in place through the remainder of 2021 data production.**

**FOOTNOTES**

1/ Estimate of workers by place of residence. These data are controlled to state Current Population Survey (CPS) data which adjusts for commuting and dual job-holding. Workers are counted where they live only once regardless of the number of jobs they may hold. All in-depth inquiries relative to the estimating methodology should be addressed to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, U.S. Department of Labor. All data are subject to revision during annual benchmarking.

2/ Includes wage and salary workers (including agriculture), self-employed persons, and unpaid family workers (including agriculture), domestic workers, and persons involved in labor-management disputes.

3/ Unemployed as percent of civilian labor force, computed using unrounded data.

4/ Seasonally adjusted MSA level data (and their equivalent) is developed by the federal Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS); seasonal adjustment for all other sub-state areas are developed by CWIA.
