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INDIANA mSA'S UNEMPLOYMENT RATE AT 4.5% IN MAY

HARRISBURG (JUNE 27) – The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for the Indiana Micropolitan Statistical Area (mSA) increased three-tenths of a percentage point over the month to 4.5 percent in May. Pennsylvania's rate was 4.0 percent, and the national rate was 3.7 percent.

Total nonfarm jobs (not seasonally adjusted) in the Indiana mSA decreased by 800 to 28,300 in May.

Jobs in government showed a seasonal decrease of 900 over the month. The decrease in government was all in state government because of the start of summer break. The other eight of the nine published supersectors of the local area were essentially unchanged since April. Over the year, mining, logging, and construction was down by 400 jobs while the other supersectors remained essentially unchanged since May 2022.

FOOTNOTES

- 1) Estimate of workers by place of residence. These data are controlled to state Current Population Survey (CPS) data which adjusts for commuting and dual job-holding. Workers are counted where they live only once regardless of the number of jobs they may hold. All in-depth inquiries relative to the estimating methodology should be addressed to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, U.S. Department of Labor. All data are subject to revision during annual benchmarking.
- 2) Includes wage and salary workers (including agriculture), self-employed persons, and unpaid family workers (including agriculture), domestic workers, and persons involved in labor-management disputes.
- 3) Unemployed as percent of civilian labor force, computed using unrounded data.
- 4) Seasonally adjusted MSA level data (and their equivalent) is developed by the federal Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS); seasonal adjustment for all other sub-state areas are developed by CWIA.
